TOYOTA is facing a major investigation following a plant explosion on October 23, which resulted in the deaths of two workers, Fabio Tosi and Lorenzo Cubello, and injured thirteen others. The accident is believed to have been caused by a poorly built heating and cooling plant that lacked a pressure relief valve, a hypothesis to be verified by a super-expert report on May 5.
